# AN AMAZING JOURNEY

## BACKGROUND

The journey of the Texas State Organization offices from the Texas Woman's University campus to the modern office building in Dallas began in 2005. The dormitory room on the TWU campus, rented in 1982, had become seriously inadequate for conducting the business and storing the valuables of a large and growing state organization that had the unique distinction of being the founding state organization of an international society. Not only was storage and office space lacking, but there was no space for any state or chapter meetings or ceremonies. Many of our state treasures had to be housed in private homes.

## MILESTONES

At the 2004 Convention in Waco a special committee was appointed and directed to investigate options for obtaining more appropriate facilities for the Texas State Organization Headquarters.

At the 2005 Convention in Dallas members voted to purchase an office in Dallas. On March 10, 2006, the Texas State Organization took a giant step forward as a professional organization by purchasing an office suite at 6220 Campbell Road, Dallas.

An open house was held on October 15, 2006, to dedicate the new building.

At the 2007 Convention in Amarillo members approved a Headquarters Committee with goals that include:

- Establishing policies for Texas State Organization Headquarters
- Overseeing the maintenance of the building
